#### **AMMENDMENTS**

*A). Amendments to this Constitution and Bylaws may be proposed by any member in good standing, in writing, to the President. The President will read the proposal in the form of a motion at the next monthly membership meeting, request a second, and allow discussion and debate. If approved by simple majority vote of the member's presents, the proposed amendment must be published in the next monthly newsletter if one exists. It shall also be published in the meeting minutes distributed to the membership via email and our Yahoo Group or similar page.*

*B) After publication, the proposed amendment must be approved by two thirds (2/3) majority vote of the members present at the next monthly meeting. The amendment will be considered effective as of the date of the final vote or as of an effective date contained in the motion.*

#### **ACTIONS TO BE TAKEN MOVING FORWARD:**

- 1- The Board has proposed the new draft at this Meeting. At the June meeting the President will read the proposal in the form of a motion, request a second, and allow discussion and debate.
  - 2- If approved by simple majority vote of the member's presents, the proposed amendment will be published in an email to everyone and posted on the website.
  - 3- It will also be published in the June meeting minutes distributed to the membership via email on our io Group.
  - 4- At the July meeting, it will be put to a vote. It can only be approved by 2/3's of the members present at the meeting.
  - 5- It can be implemented as of the date of the final vote or the effective date if contained in the motion.
