New Business

- **Ride Waiver Application-** To be filled out by guest on Club Rides. We have a few steady guest, once the form is filled out it will be kept on file.
- **Bylaws Amendment for General Meeting Quorum-** Pat Di Tore sent a written request to the President to amend the Bylaws as per our procedure to include the Board of Directors in the Quorum as currently stated in Section 4.07:
(Current Bylaw)

SECTION 4.07 Quorum

At any general, monthly or special meetings of BKSCV, the presence of ten (10) members not including the Board of Directors, shall constitute a quorum for all purposes. At all meetings of BKSCV, at which there is a quorum present, a majority of the votes cast on any matter before the meeting shall control.

At tonight's meeting there was a motion by President John Flynn to amend Section 4.07 to state:

(Proposed amendment where the word "not" is removed)

SECTION 4.07 Quorum

At any general, monthly or special meetings of BKSCV, the presence of ten (10) members **not** including the Board of Directors, shall constitute a quorum for all purposes. At all meetings of BKSCV, at which there is a quorum present, a majority of the votes cast on any matter before the meeting shall control.

Duane Ragan seconded the motion. Unanimously approved to move forward for a vote at the August General Meeting.

- **Safety-** Check tire pressure prior to ride. Look at thread wear and age of tires. On HD with hydraulic clutch. Fluid DOT 4 should be changed every two years DOT 4 Brake Fluid should be changed every two years due to its ability to attract moisture. Check fluids, Oil, Transmission, and coolant if applicable.
- **Group Riding-** Ride in staggered formation. Allow proper spacing. Try to maintain a 2 sec gap between the rider in front. When the Ride Leader in on a Trike, He/She shall stay in the middle of the traveling lane. All other trikes will be at the rear of the ride and shall ride in the middle of the traveling lane. Proper spacing is critical. Keep yourself Hydrated. Always carry a First Aid Kit. Be Careful Out There.
